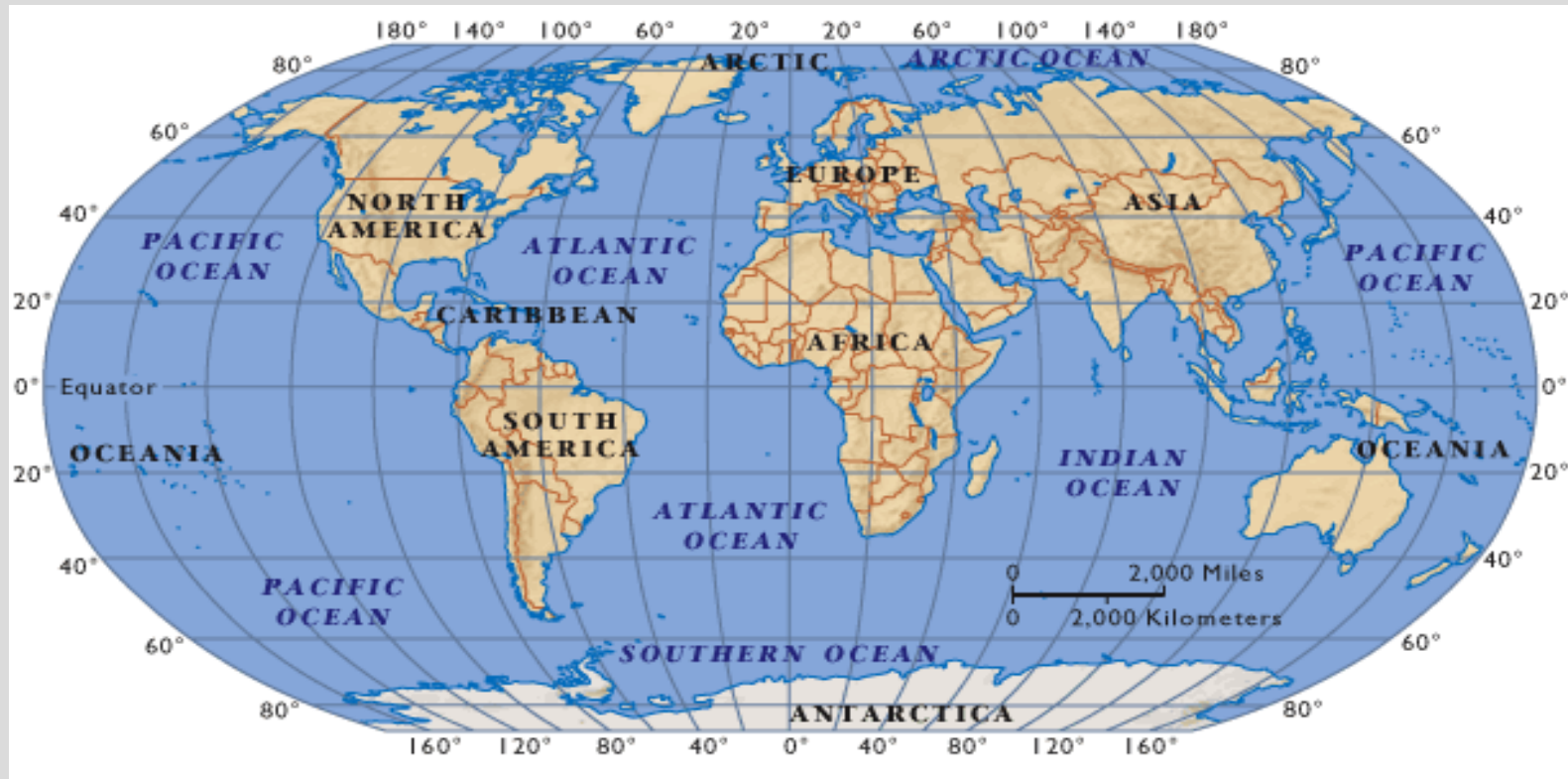

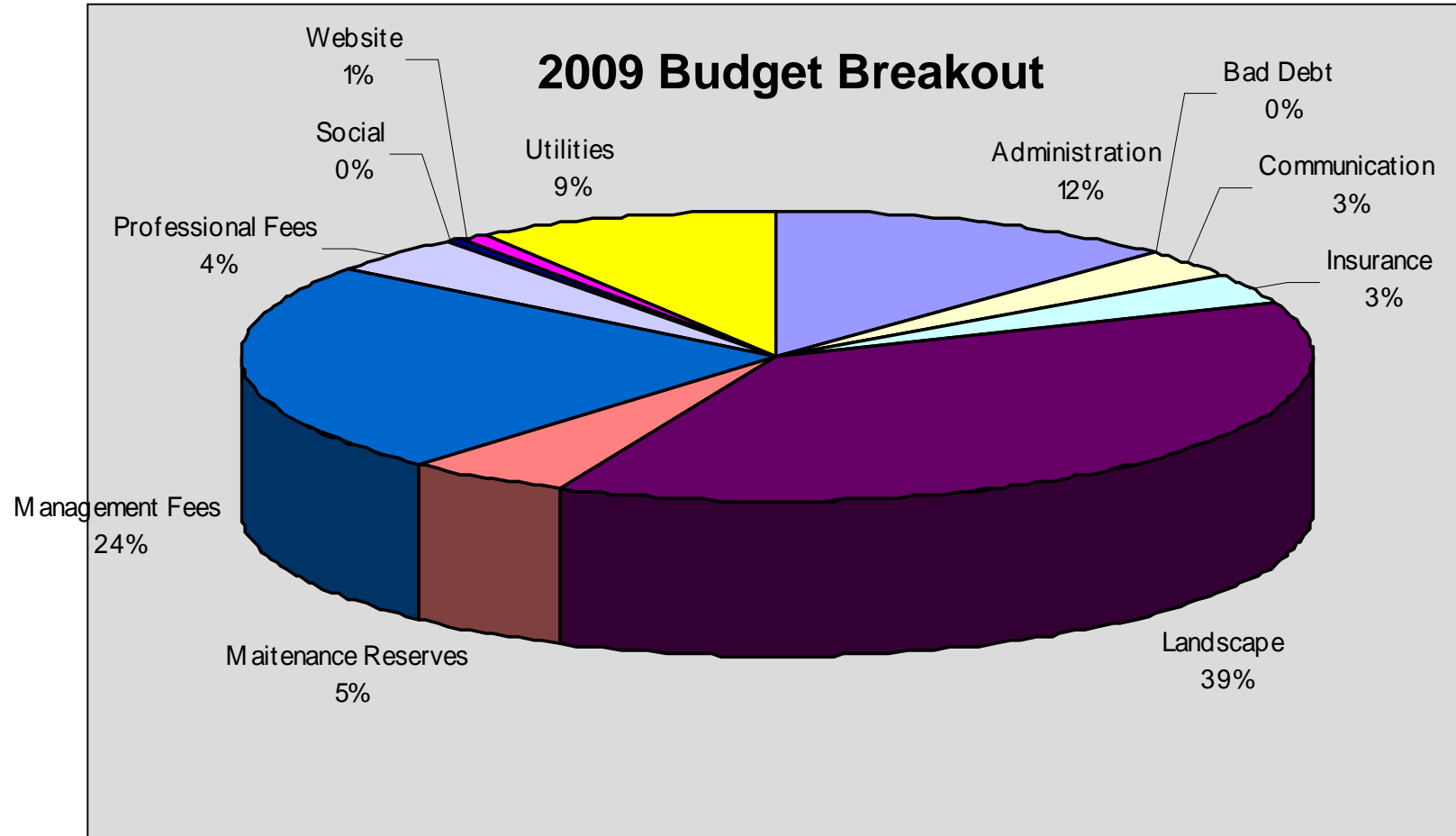

Water Restrictions for City of Roswell, GA

Effective June 2, 2008 - Spring/Summer 2008 Outdoor Water Use Restrictions

On May 6, 2008, the EPD Director **declared the Level Four Drought Response would remain in effect for 55 North Georgia counties for the summer.** A level four drought response prohibits most types of residential outdoor water use.

A. Landscapes

Each household, business or other institution/property owner will be allowed to hand water. Hand watering, defined as one person with one hose with an automatic shut off nozzle, will be allowed 25 minutes a day, on the odd/even watering schedule. Even and unnumbered addresses may water on Monday, Wednesday and Saturday and odd addresses may water on Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday between the hours of 12:00 AM (midnight) to 10:00 AM. The hand watering exemption applies to landscapes only. Irrigation systems may not be run under this exemption. An exemption is provided for new landscape installations (including aeration and over seeding). These new installations may be watered for a period of 10 weeks following installation (3 days per week) on the odd/even watering schedule as listed above. **Only newly - installed landscaping may be watered by irrigation system; all other watering must follow the hand watering exemption.**

Irrigation systems may be used to water newly - installed landscaping, but only between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 10:00 AM on the Odd/ Even schedule.

Newly installed landscape refers to turf, ornamentals, annuals and containerized plants installed within the last 30 days. Irrigation systems may be used to water-in pesticides and herbicides (professionally applied) on turf; however, watering must be done within 24 hours of initial application, between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 10:00 AM. A copy of the receipt is required to be displayed in a prominent location at the property.

D. Car Washes and Car Detailing Businesses

Washing vehicles at a residential home is not permitted under the current water restrictions. Vehicles may only be washed at a commercial car wash.

E. Pressure Washing

Pressure washing can only be performed by a licensed professional.

Any person or entity failing to comply with these restrictions is subject to fines and or termination of services.

1st Offense- \$100 fine

2nd Offense- \$500 fine

3rd Offense- may result in the termination of water services with additional fines and reconnection charges.

Welcome to the Fulton County Schools Online Redistricting Meeting

This online service allows Fulton County residents to provide input and comments during the redistricting process. The Board of Education has approved [primary and secondary criteria for rezoning](#) and only comments that apply to the criteria will be considered.

Participants who are present at the actual redistricting meetings do not have to provide input again. The number of times a comment is received is not directly correlated to the development of the alternative plans or the final proposal.

Comments will be collected and evaluated by the Planning Staff. The final Board recommendation will be presented on January 13, 2009, with final passage on February 19, 2009.

Basic Ground Rules for Participants:

- Can only consider input related to the criteria
- School system staff commits to receiving and considering all appropriate input
- Staff must balance multiple perspectives and logistical limitations in developing alternatives, not all input can be accommodated
- Respect each other's opinions
- Submit all questions in writing via [email](#), fax, or mail.

Community input will be allowed until November 3, 2008 at 12:00 noon. After this date, the online meeting site will be closed.

City Proposes Millage Rate

Released on: Monday, June 2, 2008 11:00 AM

The City of Roswell is proposing its millage rate for fiscal year 2008-2009 to remain at 5.657 mills.

Revenues in the proposed budget are projected to increase 11 percent or \$11,572,700 for a total of \$117,326,387. Expenditures are projected to increase 12 percent or \$12,050,611 for a total budget of \$116,472,303. The increase in revenue will primarily be spent on public safety and transportation.

The typical Roswell property tax bill on a \$300,000 home would remain \$678.84.
